Chicago and Surrounding Counties

Bricklayers (MARBA) 5-31-23
(Cook, DuPage, Will, Grundy, Lake, Kendall, DeKalb, Kane, McHenry)

The parties have reached an agreement on a four-year successor agreement. The agreement calls for increases of \$2.83 (3.29%), \$2.90 (3.27%), \$2.98 (3.25%), & \$2.84 (3.00%).

Bricklayers (Contractors Association of Will and Grundy Counties) 5-31-23
(Cook, DuPage, Will, Grundy, Lake, Kendall, DeKalb, Kane, McHenry)

The parties have reached an agreement on a four-year successor agreement. The agreement calls for increases of \$2.83 (3.29%), \$2.90 (3.27%), \$2.98 (3.25%), & \$2.84 (3.00%).

Heat & Frost Insulators Local 17 5-31-23
(Cook, DuPage, Will, Grundy, Kendall, Stark, Peoria, Tazewell, Woodford, Marshall, McLean, Kane, Lake, McHenry, LaSalle, Livingston, Kankakee, Putnam, Iroquois, Ford, DeKalb, Lee)

The parties have reached an agreement that has already been ratified. The agreement calls for economic increases of \$2.90 (3.40%), \$2.70 (3.03%), \$2.50 (2.72%) in Zone A and increases of \$2.50, \$2.24, \$2.00 in Zone B.

Marble Setters/Marble Finishers 5-31-23
(Cook, Lake, Will, Grundy, DuPage, Kendall, Kankakee, Kane, DeKalb, and McHenry)

The parties have reached an agreement on a four-year successor agreement which has been ratified by both parties calling for economic increases as follows: Setters \$2.77, \$2.83, \$2.91, & \$2.77 Finishers \$2.34, \$2.40, \$2.46, & \$2.35.

Pipefitters Local 597 5-31-23
(Cook, Lake, McHenry & Will)

The parties have reached an agreement on a four-year successor CBA which has been ratified by both sides. Economic increases are \$3.01, \$3.00, \$3.01, & \$2.00 respectively.

Sheet Metal Local 73 5-31-23
(Cook, Lake)

The parties have reached a three-year successor agreement which has been ratified by both sides. The agreement calls for economic increases of \$3.01 (3.24%), \$2.91 (3.03%), and \$2.88 (2.91%).

Teamsters Joint Council 25 (MARBA) 5-31-23
(Cook, Lake, DuPage, Kane, Kendall, McHenry, Grundy, Will)

The parties have reached an agreement on a four-year successor agreement which has been ratified by both parties. The agreement calls for economic increases of \$2.90 (4.3%), \$2.50 (3.54%), \$2.50 (3.42%), and \$2.50 (3.31%).

The parties have reached a three-year successor agreement calling for total economic increases of \$4.00 (4.5%), \$3.15 (3.4%), \$3.00 (3.1%).

The parties have reached a four-year successor agreement calling for economic increases of \$3.15 (4.12%), \$2.70 (3.39%), \$2.60 (3.16%), \$2.80 (3.3%).

Operating Engineers Local 150 – HHU 5-31-23

The parties have reached a four-year successor agreement calling for economic increases of \$3.15 (4.12%), \$2.70 (3.39%), \$2.60 (3.16%), \$2.80 (3.3%).

The Industrial agreement is also for five years and calls for economic increases of \$2.78, \$2.18, \$2.18, \$2.18, & \$2.18.

The parties have reached a three-year successor agreement calling for economic increases of \$3.00, \$2.00, & \$1.90. Specific locals covered under the agreement will also see some additional increases ranging from \$0.10 per hour to \$0.25 per hour.

Laborers 66 County M/U Agreement (Locals 140, 268, 330, and 464) 5-31-23
(All counties except Ozaukee, Washington, Waukesha, Milwaukee, Racine, and Kenosha)

The parties have reached a three-year successor agreement calling for economic increases of \$3.00, \$2.00, & \$1.90.
