Group 1 - Frame Truck when used for transportation purposes, Air Compressor and Welding Machines, including those pulled by cars, pick-up trucks and tractors, Ambulances, Articulated Dumps, Batch Gate Lockers, Batch Hopperman, Car and Truck Washers, Carry Alls, Fork Lifts and Hoisters, Helpers, Mechanics Helpers and Greasers, Oil Distributors, two-man operation, Pavement Breakers, Pole Trailer, up to 40 feet, Pothole Repair Trucks, Power Mower Tractors, Quick Change Barrier, Self-Propelled Chip Spreader, Shipping and Receiving Clerks and Checkers, Skipman, Slurry Trucks, two-man operation, Slurry Trucks, Conveyor Operated - 2 or 3 man operation, Teamsters, Unskilled Dumpmen, Warehousemen and Dockmen, Truck Drivers hauling warning lights, barricades, and portable toilets on the job site

Group 2 - Dispatcher, Dump Crets and Adgetors under seven (7) yards, Dumpsters, Track Trucks, Euclids, Hug Bottom Dump Turnapulls or Turnatrailers when pulling other than self-loading equipment or similar equipment under 16 cubic yards, Mixer Trucks under seven (7) yards, Ready-Mix Plant Hopper Operator, Winch Trucks, 2 Axles

Group 3 - Dump Crets and Adgetors, seven (7) yards and over, Dumpsters, Track Trucks, Euclids, Hug Bottom Dump Turnatrailers or Turnapulls when pulling other than self-loading equipment or similar equipment over 16 cubic yards, Explosives and/or Fission Material Trucks, Mixer Trucks, seven (7) yards or over, Mobile Cranes while in transit, Oil Distributors, one-man operation, Pole Trailer, over 40 feet, Pole and Expandable Trailers hauling material over 50' long, Slurry Trucks, one-man operation, Winch Trucks, three (3) axles or more, Mechanic - *Truck Welder and *Truck Painter
